## Notification of a relocation abroad for an extended period of time

### Information

According to chapter 7, 2 paragraph, 2 subparagraph of the Education act (2010:800), children residing in Sweden are subject to compulsory school attendance, in accordance to the regulations in chapter 7. Compulsory schooling does not apply, however, for children relocated abroad for an extended period of time. When assessing whether the child's stay in another country can be considered to be for an extended period of time, the child's actual circumstances are important. While it is not possible to generally state a certain minimum time for the stay abroad to be considered an extended period, a rule of thumb is that a stay of 6 to 9 months can be considered sufficient.

In order for Sollentuna municipality to be able to determine whether the child can be considered to be relocated abroad for an extended period, the information in this notification needs to be substantiated with a certificate or similar documents, for example:

- rental/housing contract
- travel documents
- employment contracts abroad for the child's guardian
- certificate of school placement abroad
- other similar documentation.

### General information

In cases where Sollentuna municipality assesses that the child is permanently relocated abroad, and thus not subject to compulsory schooling in Sweden, the child's home municipality in Sweden has a continued legal responsibility for the child as long as the child is registered in the Sweden. Therefore, the home municipality needs to receive information from the guardian at least once every school term that can certify the continued stay abroad for the child.

Please note that the information regarding the child's stay abroad as specified in this notification will be forwarded to the Swedish Tax Agency and the Swedish Social Insurance Agency
